



Billing Policies

Payment is expected the day that services are rendered. We accept cash, checks, MasterCard, or Visa.

We will be happy to provide you with an approximate estimate of what we expect the expenses to be of all your anticipated dental care, as well as an estimate of charges anticipated for your next visit. Please feel free to ask the receptionist at any time what payment might be expected for your next visit.

For most procedures, if you have dental insurance, we will bill you for the patient's estimated copayment at the time of the visit. Adjustments may be necessary once payment is received from the insurance company.

For major dental procedures (anything over \$300), you pay half on the day the procedure is begun, and any remainder on the day it is completed.

Interest charges will accrue on accounts over 30 days past due.

After 90 days, past due accounts will be sent to collections.

If you are unable to keep your appointment, 24 hours advance notice is required to avoid an additional fee of \$50.
